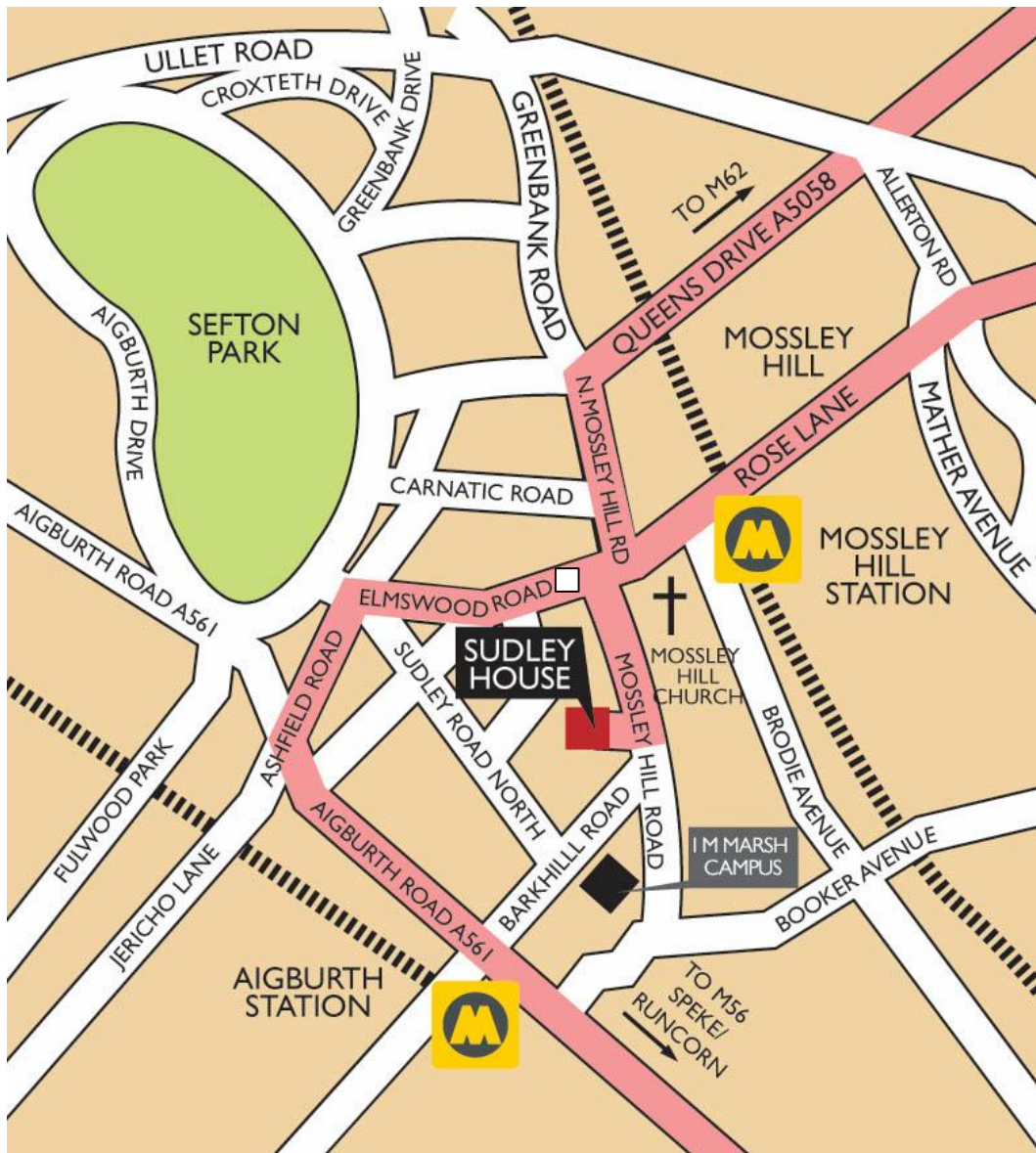


Getting to Sudley House

By train: If travelling from the city centre board at Lime Street Station - several services stop at Mossley Hill station. Alternatively, take the Southport-Hunts Cross line to Aigburth station (board at either Liverpool Central or Moorfields). This service runs every 15 mins. The walk from either station to Sudley House is 10-15 mins.

By bus: Several buses stop near Sudley House including number 61 from stand 5 at Bootle Bus Station, getting off at Elmswood Road bus stop (5 min walk to Sudley House), and 80 or 80A to Rose Lane bus stop from Great Charlotte Street in the city centre (10 mins walk).

By road: The drive from the city centre takes approximately 20 mins. The easiest route is to simply follow the road that runs alongside the river - the A5036 (it is called Wapping in the Albert Dock area). Drive south - the river will be on your right. The road will run for a few miles becoming Sefton Street and then Riverside Drive and will pass over several roundabouts - just follow the main line of traffic over them. Go past the Britannia pub and a short while later you reach a roundabout with a sign pointing left to the recycling centre. Here follow the sign left onto Jericho Lane and follow this until you reach a main traffic junction. Go straight across at these traffic lights (crossing the A561 Aigburth Road) onto Ashfield Road. At the next set of traffic lights go right onto Elmswood Road, then just before Mossley Hill church (which is on your right) turn right onto Mossley Hill Road. The entrance to Sudley House is about 500m along on your right.

Parking: Very limited at Sudley House so we strongly recommend public transport where possible. There is a single coach bay.

At the time of writing there are two temporary disabled spaces immediately outside the building in the grounds of the house, and visitors can be dropped off right outside the front door.
